

## **G56 Coordinator Position Description**

**Purpose of the role:** To develop 5th & 6th graders faith by encouraging and fostering relationships among their peers, deepening their theology and encouraging the family discipleship model found in Deuteronomy 6.

**Program description:** The focus of the G56 program is to foster relationships with God and each other in the context of the local church body. Our hope is to make every 5th & 6th grade student feel known, loved and encouraged in who Christ made them to be. While developing their growing faith, we hope to foster an environment where curiosity is welcome and students are guided

through scripture by trusted adults to find the answers to the questions they possess. G56 is FUN and full of opportunities to make long lasting memories both for children independently and together as a family unit.

**Time requirements:** The G56 Coordinator role is a part-time position requiring 10-15 hours per week. Hours are flexible.

### **Responsibilities and duties:**

- Assist Jr. High Director in recruiting and coordinating volunteers for G56 programs and events.
- Program Sunday morning gatherings according to the LifeMap model. This includes, but is not limited to, creating lesson plans and activities using the New City Catechism curriculum.
- Plan and coordinate quarterly G56 student and family outings & gatherings hosted by GSM with the assistance of the Jr. High Director.
- Write and send bi-weekly G56 parent update emails through the CCB system.
  - Build and invest in relationships with G56 students and families.

### **Qualifications and Skills:**

- Committed to a lifelong engagement with the local church and exhibits a lifestyle of Christian discipleship.
